ORDER

On February 22, 2007, the Court ordered plaintiff on or before March 2, 2007 to file a second amended complaint in compliance with Judge James O'Hara's order of August 10, 2006.¹ Doc. #410 at 7. The Court warned plaintiff that if she did not comply with the order, "her case will be dismissed with prejudice without further notice." <u>Id.</u>

The Court's docket currently reflects that plaintiff filed a second amended complaint on Friday, March 2, 2007 which was not docketed until March 7, 2007. <u>See</u> Doc. #433. The Court has determined that there may be procedural irregularities in the filing of the second amended complaint. The Court will therefore hold a hearing on Friday, March 23, 2007 at 9:30 a.m. to address the circumstances of the filing of the second amended complaint. The Court will ensure that Court personnel with knowledge pertaining to the filing will be available to testify. The parties will be have the opportunity to present evidence as well.
