MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

This Social Security appeal is before the court on the plaintiff's Motion for Attorney Fees. Plaintiff Stacy Hearlson seeks an award of attorney fees and expenses under the Equal Access to Justice Act (EAJA), 28 U.S.C. § 2412, in the amount of \$9,356.42 — representing 58.35 hours of attorney work at \$162.35 per hour.
