ORDER

This case comes before the court on the motion of Thomas E. Wright for leave to

withdraw as counsel for defendants Bibler, Newman & Reynolds, P.A., and Billy Newman

(doc. 90).

D. Kan. Rule 83.5.5 governing withdrawal of counsel provides:

An attorney seeking to withdraw must file and serve a motion to withdraw on all counsel of record, and provide a proposed order for the court. In addition, **the motion must be served personally or by certified mail, restricted delivery, with return receipt requested on the withdrawing attorney's client**. (Emphasis added.)

Mr. Wright has failed to comply with D. Kan. Rule 83.5.5 in that there has been no

evidence that he has served a copy of his motion upon his client. Notwithstanding, the court

notes that these defendants will continue to be represented by other counsel who have already

entered their appearances in this case.

In consideration of the foregoing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The above-mentioned motion (**doc. 90**) is granted.

2. Mr.Wright is granted leave to withdraw as counsel of record for defendants Bibler, Newman & Reynolds, P.A., and Billy Newman. However, Mr. Wright shall serve a copy of the motion filed along with a copy of this order upon his clients.
