## **ORDER**

Upon consideration of the United States' Second Unopposed Motion to Stay the Case and for good cause shown,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the scheduling conference currently set for January 15, 2008, is rescheduled to **April 15, 2008, at 3:00 p.m.** The conference will still occur by telephone and will be initiated by the court.
