ORDER

This matter comes before the court upon the oral motion of defendants KAN-TEX CULINARY, LLC, KAN-TEX STEAKHOUSE, INC., and Leonard H. Hammer Jr.'s ("KAN-TEX defendants"), raised during the parties' telephone scheduling conference on May 16, 2007.
