ORDER

Upon consideration of Defendant Evenflo Company Inc.'s Motion (with Consent) for Extension of Time to File a Responsive Pleading (doc. 8), it is hereby ORDERED that Evenflo's motion is GRANTED.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Defendant Evenflo has through and until **thirty (30)** **days** after the Multidistrict Litigation Panel issues a ruling on the Motion to Transfer or Consolidate in In re: Bisphenol -A (BPA) Polycarbonate Plastic Products Liability Litigation, MDL No. 1967 to answer or otherwise plead in response to Plaintiffs' Complaint.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant Evenflo will notify the Court of the Multidistrict Litigation Panel's ruling on the Motion to Transfer or Consolidate in In re: Bisphenol -A (BPA) Polycarbonate Plastic Products Liability Litigation, MDL No. 1967 **within ten (10) days** of the ruling.
