## <u>ORDER</u>

On July 30, 2008, Plaintiff Rhonda Epson filed a Motion for Leave to proceed in forma pauperis (Doc. 2) in the above related case. United States Magistrate Judge John Thomas Reid issued a Report and Recommendation regarding Plaintiff's motion (Doc. 4). Plaintiff then filed a document entitled "Plaintiff's Response to Magistrate's Report and Recommendation." (Doc. 5). Although docketed as an "Objection to Report and Recommendation," (Doc. 5), plaintiff's filing (Doc. 5) is a stipulation to the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation rather than an objection.
