## ORDER

**NOW** on this 21<sup>st</sup> day of January, 2011, the above-entitled matter comes before the Court upon the motion of counsel for the accused for an order granting additional time of one (1) day within which to file motions. The Court has reviewed the motion and is fully advised of the premises.

The hearing on said motions shall remain as scheduled on February 10, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. The period of delay resulting from such continuance shall be excludable time as provided for by the Speedy Trial Act, 18 U.S.C. 3161(h)(7).
