ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the jury trial is rescheduled for April 26, 2011 at 9:30 a.m. The period of delay resulting from such continuance shall be excludable time as provided for by the Speedy Trial Act, 18 U.S.C. 3161(h)(7).
