MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

Defendant has filed a Motion to Compel Discovery (Doc. 15) requesting an Order compelling Plaintiff to respond to discovery, and requesting an award of attorney fees as a sanction under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 37(a)(5).
