## MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

This matter is before the court on the plaintiff's Motion to Strike Affirmative defenses (Dkt. 13). The Motion to Strike was addressed as a Report and Recommendation in the United States Magistrate Judge's Memorandum and Order filed previously in the case. (Dkt. 20). In that Order, Judge Gale granted as uncontested defendant Heartland Habitat for Humanity's Motion for Leave to File an Amended Pleading (Dkt. 15), the purpose of which was to supply information in support of the challenged defenses.
