## MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

This matter is a petition for habeas corpus filed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. By its Memorandum and Order entered on August 2, 2011 (Doc. 2), the court directed petitioner to show cause why this matter should not be dismissed due to petitioner's failure to commence this action within the one-year limitation period established by 28 U.S.C. § 2244(d).
