## ORDER ADOPTING REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

This case is before the court on Garnishee Trisura Guarantee Insurance Company's Motion to Dismiss or, in the Alternative, to Quash Writ of Garnishment (Doc. 51). On February 8, 2017, Judge James P.
