## **ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

Johnson, and Brenda West Hagerman, and his 18 U.S.C. § 241, 18 U.S.C. § 1001, 42 U.S.C. § 1981, and equal protection claims against all defendants for failure to state a claim, as Magistrate Judge Waxse recommended in his September 23, 2015 order (Doc. 6). If plaintiff does not file a timely response, the court will enter an order adopting Judge Waxse's recommendations and dismissing the claims and defendants identified here.
