SECOND AMENDED SCHEDULING ORDER

Proposed pretrial order due	May 28, 2019
Pretrial conference	June 6, 2019 at 9:00 AM
Trial	February 18, 2020 at 9:30 AM

All other provisions of the first amended scheduling order shall remain in effect.

The schedule adopted in this second amended scheduling order shall not be modified except by leave of court upon a showing of good cause.
