ORDER ADOPTING REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

Fourteen days having passed, and no written objections being filed to the proposed findings and recommendations filed by Magistrate Judge Gwynne E. Birzer, and after a de novo determination upon the record pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 72(b), the Court accepts as its own the recommended decision to deny Plaintiffs' Motions to Proceed in forma pauperis, and to dismiss this case under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B)(ii) for failure to state a claim upon which relief may be granted (Doc. 7).¹
