MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

This matter is a pro se petition for writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2254 that the Court dismissed with prejudice on May 23, 2022 as untimely filed. (Doc. 11.) On June 6, 2022, Petitioner filed a document which the Court liberally construed as a motion to reconsider the dismissal and denied on June 9, 2022. (Docs. 13, 15.)
