MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Court on Petitioner's petition for writ of habeas corpus (Doc. 1) and motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis (Doc. 2), both filed March 22, 2022, and Petitioner's motion to dismiss (Doc. 3), filed March 24, 2022.
