MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

Shortly after this Court entered its order dismissing without prejudice this pro se civil rights action brought by Plaintiff Christopher Tahchawwickah, the Court received in the mail documents from Plaintiff that seek to add “additional evidence.” (Doc. 14.)
